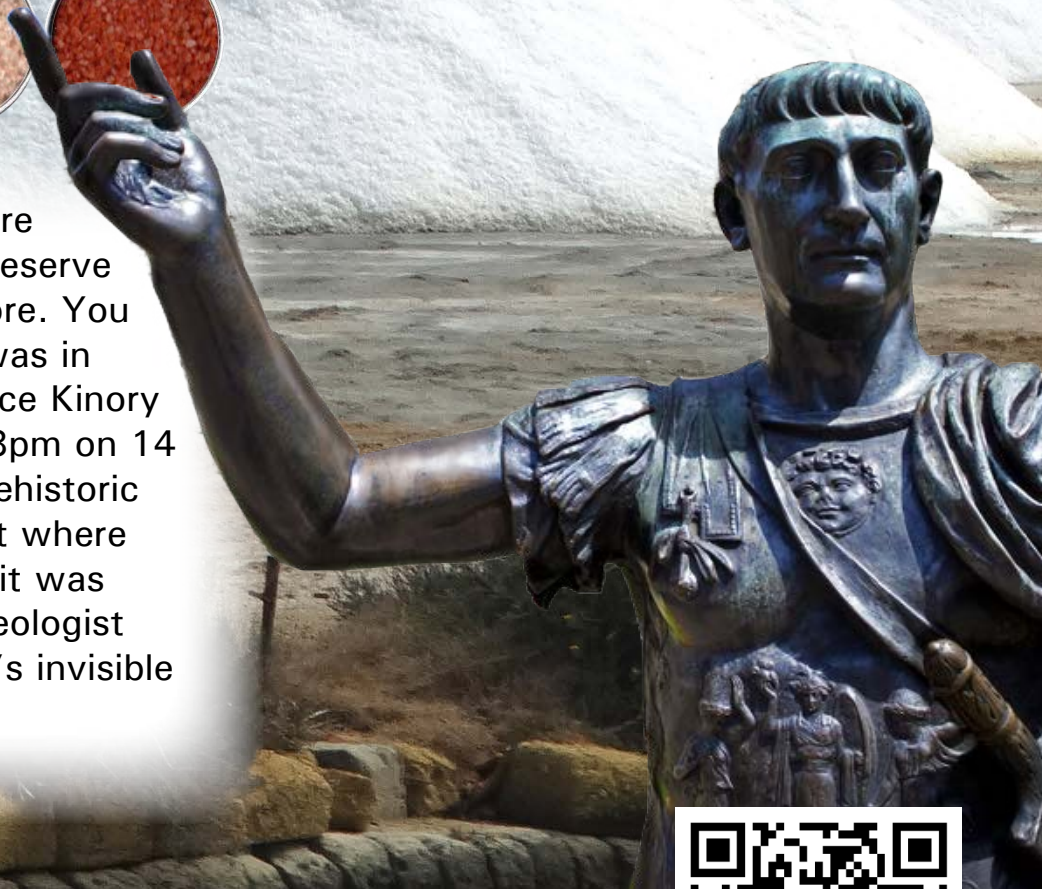
# Salt in Prehistoric and Roman Britain
